

The Software Engineering Prize

PRIZE RULES

Establishment

This prize has been established by the University for the purpose of funding a prize that recognises and encourages talent in all aspects of Software Engineering.

In support of the prize the School of Computer Science shall provide an annual amount of \$1000.00 (GST free) from internally sourced funds.

Value

The value of the prize will be \$1000.00 per year from 2017, until otherwise determined by the School of Computer Science.

Eligibility

The prize will be awarded annually by the University to eligible students from any degree across the University who complete a project in Software Engineering in the year for which the prize is awarded.

Selection of Candidate

The Head of the School of Computer Science (or nominee), will award the prize to students who attain the best group project mark for a Software Engineering Project completed in (but not limited to) a course such as COMP SCI 3006 Software Engineering and Project.

The prize shall be shared equally amongst all members of the group who completed the best Software Engineering Project.

If there is no candidate of sufficient merit in a given year then the prize will not be awarded in that year and the money will be used in subsequent years.

Variations

The University may vary the rules from time to time in a manner consistent with the original objectives of the prize.
