
The ElectraNet Prize in Power Systems PRIZE RULES

Establishment

This Prize has been established by a contribution to the University by ElectraNet Pty Ltd.

In support of the prize ElectraNet Pty Ltd shall provide to the University as a result of a pledge request, an annual amount equivalent to \$500.00 (GST free).

Value

The value of the Prize will be \$500 per year, until otherwise determined by the University after discussions with the contributor.

Eligibility

The prize will be awarded by the University annually to a student enrolled in the Bachelor of Engineering (Honours) (Electrical and Electronic).

Selection of Candidate

The Head of the School of Electrical and Electronic Engineering will award the prize to the student who obtains the best overall result in the assessment of the Level III course ELEC ENG 3110 Power Systems.

If there is no candidate of sufficient merit in a given year then the prize will not be awarded in that year and the money will be used in subsequent years.

If there is more than one candidate of equal merit, then the prize shall be shared equally.

Variations

The University may vary the rules from time to time in a manner consistent with the original objectives of the prize. The title of the prize shall not be changed.
