

# The Electric Energy Society of Australia (EESA) Prize PRIZE RULES

#### **Establishment**

This Prize has been established by a contribution to the University by The Electric Energy Society of Australia (EESA).

In support of the prize The Electric Energy Society of Australia (EESA) shall provide to the University as a result of a pledge request, an annual amount equivalent to \$500.00 (GST free).

#### Value

The value of the Prize will be \$500.00 per year, until otherwise determined by the University after discussions with the contributor.

# **Eligibility**

The prize will be awarded by the University annually and is open to students undertaking the Level II course ELEC ENG 2102 Electric Energy Conversion.

### **Selection of Candidate**

The Head of the School of Electrical and Electronic Engineering will award the prize to the student who obtains the best overall result in the assessment of the Level II course ELEC ENG 2102 Electric Energy Conversion.

If there is no candidate of sufficient merit in a given year then the prize will not be awarded in that year and the money will be used in subsequent years

If there is more than one candidate of equal merit, then the prize shall be shared equally.

## **Variations**

The University may vary the rules from time to time in a manner consistent with the original objectives of the prize.
