

The ASP Master of Petroleum Engineering Prize

Establishment

This Prize has been established by the Australian School of Petroleum in recognition of high achieving Master of Petroleum Engineering students in the field of petroleum engineering studying with the Australian School of Petroleum

In support of the prize the Australian School of Petroleum shall provide an annual amount of \$500.

Value

The value of the Prize will be \$500.00 per year until otherwise determined by the University.

Eligibility

The prize will be awarded annually by the University to eligible students enrolled in the Master of Petroleum Engineering degree at the Australian School of Petroleum.

In order for this prize to be awarded, a minimum of ten actively enrolled HCMUT students across 3rd and 4th year is required.

Selection of Candidate

The Head of the Australian School of Petroleum (or nominee) will award the prize to the graduating MPE student who placed highest in order of academic merit for courses presented overall towards the degree.

If there is no candidate of sufficient merit in a given year then the prize will not be awarded in that year and the money will be used in subsequent years.

If there is more than one candidate of equal merit, then the prize shall be shared equally.

Variations

The University may vary the rules from time to time in a manner consistent with the original objectives of the prize.
