

## The BP Petroleum Geoscience Postgraduate Prize

### Establishment

This Prize has been established by a contribution to the University by BP Australia Pty. Ltd. in recognition of high achieving Petroleum Geoscience Masters by Coursework students studying with the Australian School of Petroleum.

In support of the prize BP Australia Pty. Ltd. shall provide to the University an annual amount of \$500.00 (GST free).

### Value

The value of the Prize will be \$500.00 per year until otherwise determined by the University after discussions with the contributor.

### Eligibility

The prize will be awarded annually by the University to eligible students enrolled in the Master of Science (Petroleum Geoscience) degree.

### Selection of Candidate

The Australian School of Petroleum (or nominee) will award the prize to the Masters student who placed highest in order of academic merit.

If there is no candidate of sufficient merit in a given year then the prize will not be awarded in that year and the money will be used in subsequent years.

If there is more than one candidate of equal merit, then the prize shall be shared equally.

### Variations

The University may vary the rules from time to time in a manner consistent with the original objectives of the prize.
